Transfer Scholarships

Collin College Foundation announces the second year of the Transfer Scholarship Program for students transferring from Collin College to pursue a baccalaureate degree. This scholarship is through the generous support of The Hites Family Community College Scholarship Foundation and the Royden L. Lebrecht Estate.

Two scholarships will be awarded at \$1,500 each and are renewable for a second year if a student is classified as a full-time student at the university throughout the semester. Additionally, students must maintain a 2.75 GPA during the first semester and a 3.0 GPA cumulative grade point average during each of the following semester.

To be eligible for this scholarship, students must meet the following criteria:

1. Earned a minimum 3.5 GPA from Collin,
2. Accumulated 50 semester hours of course credit at Collin,
3. Be accepted and enrolled as a full-time student in a regionally accredited four-year educational institution leading to a baccalaureate degree,
4. Have financial need
5. Demonstrate a record of community service and civic engagement.

Priority will be given to students transferring to one of the following pre-admission partner universities:

Texas Tech University
Texas Women's University
University of North Texas
University of Texas at Dallas
